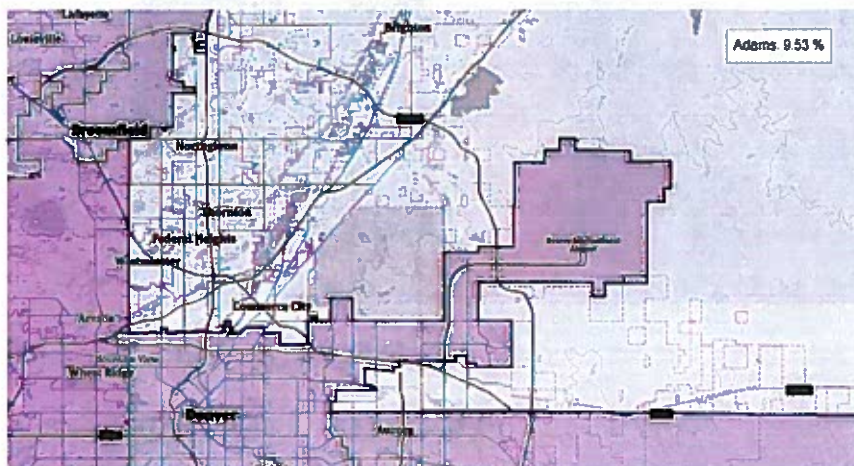

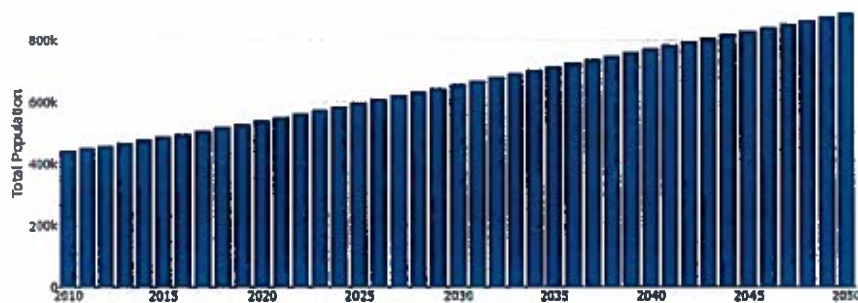

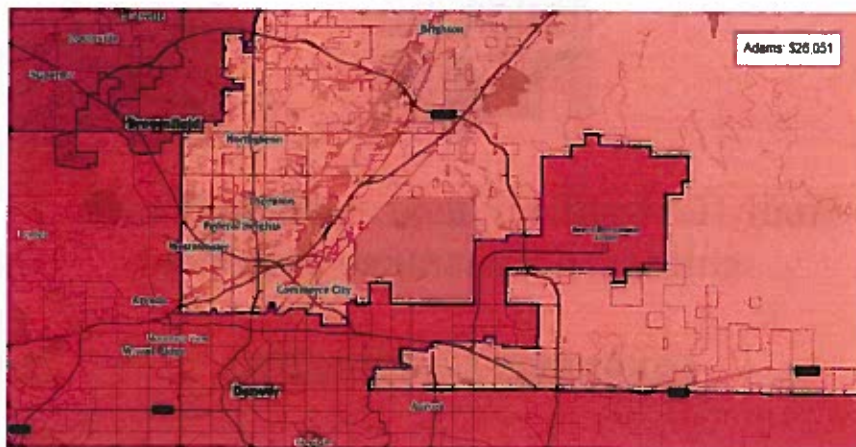


Future Growth Projections
