#### **Buffalo Run Construction 1995**

- 18-hole championship course
- Irrigation critical to construction of golf course
- Approximately 100 acres of turf irrigated and maintained
- Current irrigation system is 26 years old







## **Buffalo Run Irrigation Failures**

- Failures in the irrigation system create ongoing maintenance problems
- Turf grass conditions deteriorate over time when irrigation system fails
- Customer satisfaction declines when turf conditions are sub-par









#### **Buffalo Run Irrigation Repairs**

- Staff members spend more time repairing and replacing components as the system reaches the end of it's expected lifespan
- Replacement of the systems was identified as a priority in the 2014 Strategic Master Plan









## **Buffalo Run New Irrigation Benefits**

- Reduction in overall water usage for the golf course
- Improved conditions for customers
- Less time replacing/repairing broken sprinkler heads
- Completes one of the goals identified in the Strategic Master Plan









### **Buffalo Run Irrigation Replacement**

#### Components to be replaced:

- <u>Electrical control boxes</u> relays the signal from the computer to engage zones
- Irrigation heads new heads would have variable control from 360 degrees to 1 degree (and anything between)
- <u>Computer system</u> allows for complete control of watering cycles, times, etc.
- <u>Pipes</u> all mainline pipes and laterals will be replaced
- <u>Pump station</u> main building and pumps that bring water from the lake to pipes
