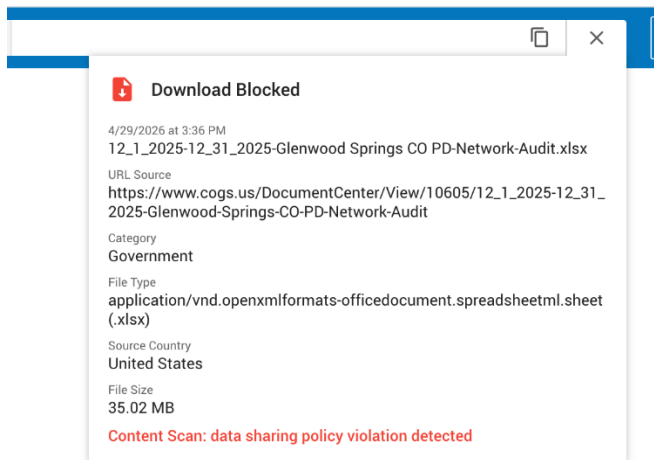

Dear Commerce City Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem, and Councilmembers,

We are writing to offer a correction to a community letter concerning the Flock Contract that was submitted to the public record on March 2<sup>nd</sup> by multiple community partners (Agenda item 26-043, titled "Written Comments 3"). One of the hyperlinks in the letter ceased to function properly after the letter was submitted, specifically the link in this sentence "*Finally, according to the latest available audit from another jurisdiction, as of December 2025, Flock was sharing Commerce City's surveillance data with over 6,300 law enforcement agencies across the country.*"

This was a link to the City of Glenwood Springs Audit of their Flock Safety database. I believe many browsers / spam blockers automatically blocked the link given the file size (See below).



To supplement this, we are providing the direct link that if copied into a browser should lead to the file referenced.
