AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2013 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, BY APPROPRIATING A PORTION OF THE UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCE OF THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY FUND AND TRANSFERRING TO THE CIPP FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$159,860 AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

There is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered fund balance in the Information Technology Fund an amount of \$14,000 for PD Advances Authentication Implementation, \$70,860 for PD Evidence Management System, \$15,000 for PD Professional Standards Software System, and \$60,000 for IT Teleworks IVR System Upgrade for a total of \$159,860 in the CIPP Fund.
