AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2012 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$529,000 TO BE USED FOR FAIRFAX PARK RENOVATIONS WHICH INCLUDE A REDESIGNED COURT AREA WITH TWO BASKETBALL COURTS, TWO TENNIS COURTS, TWO HANDBALL COURTS, IMPROVEMENTS TO THREE BALL FIELDS, AND UNDERGROUNDING POWER LINES AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2012 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Adams County Open Space Grant in the amount of \$529,000 to be used for Fairfax Park renovations which include a redesigned court area with two basketball courts, two tennis courts, two handball courts, improvements to three ball fields and undergrounding power lines.
