AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2019 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY APPROPRIATING A PORTION OF THE UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCE OF THE CIPP FUND AND TRANSFERRING A PORTION OF THE UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCE IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE DIA MITIGATION PROJECT AND PROPERTY ACQUISITION ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF EAST 88TH AVENUE IN COMMERCE CITY AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1: The prior appropriations in the CIPP Fund are hereby appropriated into the 2019 Budget for a total of \$1,778,217.29. DIA Noise Mitigation Project – Property Acquisition
SECTION 2: There is hereby transferred from the General Fund to the CIPP Fund for a total of \$21,782.71. DIA Noise Mitigation Project – Property Acquisition
SECTION 3: The expenditure of the funds herein appropriated, transferred, and reaffirmed is hereby authorized.
SECTION 4: This ordinance is in the best interests of the City and the general public.
SECTION 5: This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
