AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ARTICLES XIV, XV, AND XVI OF CHAPTER 5 OF THE COMMERCE CITY REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE GOVERNING ELEVATORS AND ESCALATORS, PLATFORM AND CHAIR WAY LIFTS, AND THE PERFORMANCE CODE FOR BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES, RESPECTIVELY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Articles XIV, XV, and XVI of Chapter 5 of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code, entitled “Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators,” “Safety Standard for Platform Lifts and Stairway Chairlifts,” and “International Code Council Performance Code for Buildings and Facilities,” respectively, are hereby repealed. This action shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to this ordinance taking effect.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
