ORDINANCE NO. 2562

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING COMMERCE CITY REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE (CCRMC) SECTION 2-2001 TO DECREASE THE NUMBER OF REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS FROM THREE TO TWO A MONTH AND INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDY SESSIONS FROM ONE TO TWO A MONTH

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Charter of the City of Commerce City ("Charter"), the City Council of the City of Commerce City ("City") has all legislative powers and functions of municipal government as reserved to it by the Colorado Constitution and the laws of the state of Colorado:

WHEREAS, Section 4.21 of the Charter requires that the City Council shall provide, by ordinance, the time, place, and number of regular council meetings each month;

WHEREAS, Section 2-2001 of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code (the "Code") describes the times, place, and number of regular meetings of the City Council;

WHEREAS, Section 4.24 of the Charter provides that "no formal or legally binding action by the council for the city shall be taken at any such [...] study sessions";

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2539, City Council explicitly permitted meetings to occur by electronic means and provided that regular meetings will occur on the first, second, and third Mondays of each month, while study sessions would occur on the fourth Mondays of every month;

WHEREAS, City Council desires to decrease the number of regular meetings to two every month to allow an additional study session in order for City Council to have more opportunities for discussion on topics, programs, and proposed legislation before being brought forward at a regular meeting for official action, but retain the ability to change by motion the time, location or cancel any regular meeting or study session as necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.
- **SECTION 2. Amendments.** Section 2-2001 of the CCRMC is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A.
- **SECTION 3. Repealer**. All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date**. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.

  - (2) Allows the public to hear and view, if the meeting is visible and the person has adequate technological connection, the meeting, public statements by councilmembers and staff, city council votes, and materials presented to councilmembers; and
  - (3) Allows for public comment in accordance with applicable council policies.
