Project Scope



Original Plan:

 Project limits changed based on Council retreat in January 2016

Current Plan:

- 72nd Avenue to just south of 112th Avenue (6.6 miles)
- North of 112th Avenue to I-76 (1.0 miles) will be constructed with the 112th Avenue roadway improvements project, including bridge over O'Brian Canal




