

**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSED MILL LEVY INCREASE FOR
SOUTH ADAMS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 4 ON THE
NOVEMBER 5, 2013 ELECTION BALLOT
NO. 2013-59**

WHEREAS, South Adams County Fire Protection District No. 4, Adams County, Colorado (the "District"), is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado, acting pursuant to the provisions of Article 1 of Title 32 of the Colorado Revised Statutes and has been established for the purpose of providing fire protection services within the District; and

WHEREAS, The District provides fire protection services to the City of Commerce City, Colorado (the "City") and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that it is in the public interest and that necessity demands the imposition of property taxes as described in the Ballot Issue attached as Appendix A; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that there are not sufficient funds in the treasury of the District and it does not anticipate that existing sources of revenue will be sufficient to generate the moneys necessary to undertake the projects and purposes referenced in the ballot issue or to pay the operation and maintenance expenses related to, among other things, said projects; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens to proclaim its support for passage of the attached Ballot Issue because the proposed mill levy increase is necessary to allow the District to continue providing the same level of fire protection services that it has provided in the past and is currently providing to Commerce City residents and businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Commerce City, Colorado supports and is in favor of the South Adams County Fire Protection District No. 4 Ballot Issue which will be on the ballot for the November 5, 2013 election.
