

Proclamation



WHEREAS, May 17, 2014, is the fourth National Kids to Parks Day organized and launched by the National Park Trust, which empowers kids to get outdoors and visit America's parks; and

WHEREAS, Commerce City is committed to providing active living amenities for youth and families, constructing four new parks and recreation projects over the next five years thanks to voters who dedicated future sales tax revenues; and
