

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING TERMS AND TERM LIMITS FOR  
COMMISSIONERS OF THE COMMERCE CITY HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD**

**NO. 2022-71**

WHEREAS, the Commerce City Housing Authority Board was established by Resolution 79-13 on August 20, 1979; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes §29-4-205(3)(b) provides that the term of office for commissioners shall be set by the council by resolution, not to exceed five years in length, or if the council has not acted, five years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Commerce City has not passed a resolution setting terms of office for commissions of the Commerce City Housing Authority Board; and

WHEREAS, the term length and term limits of each board and commissions vary and City Council desires to make all term limits and lengths consistent amongst all boards and commission where applicable; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Findings.** The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**Section 2. Amendment.** Resolutions 79-13 section 3 subparagraph c is hereby amended to state “the terms of office for the members shall be three (3) year terms and members shall serve no more than two (2) consecutive terms or until a successor has been appointed.”

**Section 3. Applicability of Charter and Council Policies.** The commission and its membership and appointments shall be subject to the requirements of the City Charter, as amended, applicable Council Policies, as amended, and Colorado Revised Statute Title 29, as amended.
