To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of the City Council, I am writing to share our support for the City of Commerce City's sixth consecutive year as a Playful City USA. We continue to be honored by this national acknowledgement of our efforts to increase play opportunities for more than 18,000 children in our community.

As the fourth-fastest growing city in Colorado, Commerce City has one of the youngest and most diverse populations – the average age of our community is 31 and more than 47 percent of our residents are of Hispanic descent. Creating play spaces as well as providing active living and healthy lifestyles opportunities for people of all ages has been a top priority for the city.

In November, Commerce City voters approved Issue 2K referred by city council. Issue 2K, a one percent sales and use tax increase, will fund five parks, recreation and road improvements over the next five years, including:

- New recreation center with an indoor pool at Second Creek Community Park
 - New additions to the existing recreation center, including a new therapy pool
 - Seasonal outdoor pool in the southern part of the city
 - Three new neighborhood parks in Fronterra, Turnberry and Villages at Buffalo Run East
- The increase also will provide a dedicated revenue source to construct, operate and maintain road, park and recreation projects in the future.

The city continues to provide unique programming and activities that encourage play in the community. From geocaching classes to Music in the Park, more than 480,000 visits were recorded at our seasonal recreation programs, 25 miles of trails, award-winning golf course, and 700 acres of parks and open space.
