AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2014 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE SALES AND USE TAX REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2014 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$78,000,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PARKS, RECREATION, AND ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2014 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the Sales and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2014 in the amount of \$78,000,000. These funds are to be used for the construction, installation, operation and maintenance of parks, recreation, and roadway improvements including but not limited to a new recreation center in the northern area of the city, major improvements to Tower Road, a new seasonal outdoor pool in the southern area of the city, three new neighborhood parks located in the subdivisions of Turnberry, Fronterra, and the Villages of Buffalo Run East, and additions to the existing southern recreation center (Fund 395).
