

RESOLUTION APPOINTING SUBSTITUTE MUNICIPAL JUDGES

NO. 2017-25

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.4 of the Charter of the City of Commerce City, the City Council is authorized to appoint regular judges to assist the presiding judge under such terms, conditions and qualifications as shall be determined by the City Council of the City of Commerce City (“City Council”);

WHEREAS, after conducting a search for substitute judges, the presiding judge has recommended the appointment of Tammara Bauer as an associate judge and Melissa Beato as a relief judge to serve in the event of the presiding judge’s absence, disqualification, or inability to act in any matter or case;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to accept the recommendation of the presiding judge and to establish terms for the appointment of the substitute judges;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Tammara Bauer is appointed as an associate municipal court judge for the City of Commerce City and shall be compensated, as a variable hour, non-benefited employee of the City, at the rate of \$100.00 per hour plus the payment of annual membership to the Colorado Municipal Judges Association.
2. Melissa Beato is appointed as a relief municipal court judge for the City of Commerce City, as a variable hour, non-benefited employee of the City, and shall be compensated at the rate of \$100.00 per hour.
3. The appointments made by this resolution shall continue until the resignation of the judge or revocation of the appointment by the City Council.
