

ORDINANCE NO. 2414

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF AN OUTDOOR FITNESS COURT® AS PART OF THE 2022 NATIONAL FITNESS CAMPAIGN

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City has been awarded a Adams County Open Space Grant in the amount of \$100,000 to fund the expense of building an outdoor fitness court as part of the 2022 National Fitness Campaign.; and

WHEREAS, in November 1999, the citizens of Adams County passed a county-wide one-fifth of one percent Open Space Sales Tax (the “Tax”); and

WHEREAS, in November 2004, the citizens of Adams County reauthorized the Tax and increased it to one-fourth of one percent; and

WHEREAS, in November 2020, the citizens of Adams County authorized the permanent extension of the existing county-wide sales tax of one-fourth of one percent for the continuing purpose of preserving open space and creating and maintaining parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the revenues collected are distributed to qualifying jurisdictions through a competitive grant process; and

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2022, the City of Commerce City applied for an Adams County Open Space Grant to complete the Fitness Court project(the Project); and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2022, Adams County awarded the City of Commerce City an Adams County Open Space Grant to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, Adams County has awarded 50% of the total projects cost, not to exceed \$100,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. An amendment is made to adopt and allocate funds for an outdoor fitness court as part of the 2022 National Fitness Campaign with funds from National Fitness Campaign grant, CDBG, and Adams County Open Space Grant in the amounts of \$30,000, \$70,000, and \$100,000 respectively.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is in the best interests of the City and shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
