AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE WALMART LOCAL COMMUNITY GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,500 TO SUPPORT YOUTH SERVICES BIKE PROGRAMS AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$4,500 from the local Commerce City Walmart #2752 to fund youth services and bike program events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. An amendment is made to the 2023 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Walmart Grant in the amount of \$4,500 to be used for youth services and bike programs and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized. (Fund 180)

SECTION 2. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest. The money from this grant will help provide bicycles to youth in Commerce City.
