

## **2021 CAPER SUMMARY**

Each year the City of Commerce City reports the performance of its Community Development Block Group (CDBG) program to HUD. This report is called the Consolidated Annual Performance & Evaluation Report (CAPER). CDBG program services are intended to serve low- to moderate-income households (LMI). Some of these accomplishments are highlighted below.

In the 2021 Program Year running from October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022, the City expended.

Public Services: The City helped 96 households fleeing domestic violence and abuse to avoid homelessness and remain stably housed.



Housing: The City assisted 15 households with essential repairs and weatherization updates in order to preserve and protect the City's housing stock.



**Public Infrastructure:** The City funded the installation of a fitness court at Monaco Park.



**Seniors:** The City assisted the elderly and those with disabilities through programs run by Audio Information Network and The Senior.
