## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT SERVICES FOR JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP, INC.

## NO. 2019-61

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") desired to engage in a third-party consultant to provide professional engineering services and technical support for the Department of Public Works ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, following a formal bidding process in compliance with the City's Procurement Policy, the City Manager approved a Master Services Agreement dated July 13, 2017 ("Agreement") with Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. ("Contractor") to provide the Services on a work order basis, subject to the limitation that the total compensation payable under the Agreement would not exceed a maximum aggregate amount of \$250,000 without approval of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City has issued 4 work orders and two Amendments for various Services with a total anticipated expenditure of \$324,449.40 and desires to issue a fifth work order to provide additional Development Review through October 9, 2019, for the amount of \$75,000 ("Work Order No. 5"); and

WHEREAS, the additional anticipated costs to the City of Work Order No. 5 will cause the aggregate amount to be expended under the Agreement to exceed \$250,000, and, pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Agreement and Work Order No. 5 are found to be in the best interest of the City.
- 2. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute Work Order No. 5 pursuant to the Agreement for an amount not to exceed \$75,000.
