## Draft Five-Year CIP Follow-up REVISED Capital Project Status List

At the Winter Retreat on 2/24/23, City Council was provided a list of 239 Projects, of which 123 are capital projects (this was previously reported as 124, however is truly 123 - the 716 - FullCourt Text Messaging project was counted twice as both an active and an unfunded project - this is an active project, so has been removed from the unfunded project count). The list below contains the 123 capital projects from the Winter Retreat list with details regarding the current status of each project. This list was originally provided to City Council for the 2024 Budget - Preliminary Session #1 presentation on 8/7/23, then revised for the 2024 Budget - Preliminary Session #3 presentation on 8/21/23. Revisions include the addition of the Ward and Description columns along with needed clarifications and corrections that were made, which are highlighted in red font.
