

ORDINANCE NO. 2116

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2016 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, TRANSFERRING A PORTION OF THE UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCE IN THE GENERAL FUND TO THE CIPP FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,155,000, TRANSFERRING \$2,600,000 FROM THE FLEET FUND TO THE CIPP FUND, TRANSFERRING \$2,362,000 FROM THE IMPACT FEE FUND (ROAD AND DRAINAGE) TO THE CIPP FUND AND TRANSFERRING \$2,750,000 FROM THE CIPP FUND TO THE IMPACT FEE FUND FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$8,867,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby transferred from the General Fund to the CIPP Fund for Highway 2 in the amount of \$1,155,000.

Section 2 There is hereby transferred from the Fleet Fund to the CIPP Fund for Highway 2 in the amount of \$2,600,000.

Section 3. There is hereby transferred from the Impact Fee Fund (Road Impact Fee) and Impact Fee Fund (Drainage Impact Fee) to the CIPP fund as follows:

CIPP Fund (Drainage) – Highway 2	\$ 862,000
CIPP Fund (Road) – Highway 2	\$1,500,000

Section 4. There is hereby transferred from the CIPP Fund to the Impact Fee fund in the amount of \$2,750,000.
