

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE
CITY OF BRIGHTON REGARDING ANNEXATION BOUNDARY AND PLANNING
COOPERATION**

WHEREAS, Brighton and Commerce City are parties to an Intergovernmental Agreement dated February 7, 1989 (“1989 IGA”) that was intended to address the impact of the new international airport, especially as it related to annexation, revenue sharing, planning and development between the two cities; and

WHEREAS, circumstances have changed since the execution of the 1989 IGA and it is in the best interests of both Parties to terminate and replace the 1989 IGA but to continue to provide for the orderly annexation of properties along the Parties’ boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Annexation Boundary and Planning Cooperation is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such Agreement on behalf of the City in substantially the form presented at this meeting, with such technical additions, deletions, and variations as the City Attorney may deem necessary or appropriate and not inconsistent with this Resolution.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
