A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR FAIRFAX PARK PLAYGROUND

Summary and Background Information:

Fairfax Park is the second largest park in Commerce City, at 23 acres in size, located at 6850 Fairfax Drive. The Fairfax Park playground is at the end of its useful life and in need of replacement. A public outreach process was conducted in Q1 2024 and a new playground design was selected by the residents through the outreaches. A Request for Bids for demolition of the old playground, installation of the new playground, and poured-in-place surfacing was released in Q4 of 2024, and A to Z Recreation is the selected contractor for the work with an award amount of \$350,000. Once a Notice to Proceed is issued the contractor will have approximately 60 days to complete the project.
