

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY #CP-2, COUNCIL NORMS AND STANDARDS, SECTION F, COUNCIL OPTIONS FOR KEEPING INFORMED**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2. Amendments.** Council Policy #CP-2, Council Norms and Standards, section F, Council Options for Keeping Informed, subparts 1 and 2, are amended to read as follows:

1. Council members are encouraged to use appropriate means to keep informed including the leveraging of technology for this purpose. Appropriate means may include, but shall not be limited to, media, recordings, minutes, and notes, in order to find out what is being considered by a committee or commission.
2. Council members may review available materials on planning-related items, subject to appropriate materials that are a part of the record in land use cases
