AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2012 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO AUTOMOBILE THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY BOARD (CATPA) GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,100 FOR CAMERAS, ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS, OVERTIME COSTS, AND ANNUAL MAINTENANCE FEES FOR PIPS SYSTEM AND I2 SOFTWARE AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2012 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Colorado Automobile Theft Prevention Authority Board (CATPA) in the amount of \$20,100 to be used for cameras, administrative costs, overtime costs, and annual maintenance fees for PIPS system and i2 software.
