

Design and Construction Services for the Automated Traffic Signal Performance Measures (ATSPM) to Lighthouse Transportation Group, LLC

March 20, 2023

#### Overview

- City received a grant from CDOT for implementation of an ATSPM for the City's arterial road network,
- Arterial roadways carry the most traffic in the City
- Most delay is experienced at the signalized intersections
- Imperative the signal timing is efficient and optimized to minimize delay for all modes of mobility traveling through intersections
- Performance measures are developed from a software using data collected from the signal controller

## Scope of Work

- Replacing controllers at seven intersections
  - E. 56<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Holly
  - E. 56<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Monaco
  - Quebec and E. 72<sup>nd</sup> Ave.
  - E. 104th Ave. and Potomac
  - E. 104<sup>th</sup> Ave. and King Soopers Drive
  - Tower Road and E. 96th Ave.
- Upgrading detection systems at five intersections
  - Hwy. 2 and E. 72<sup>nd</sup> Ave.
  - Hwy. 2 and Quebec/Rosemary
  - Hwy. 2 and E. 88th Ave.
  - Hwy. 2 and E. 104<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Installing a communication system at three intersections
  - Hwy. 2 and E. 72<sup>nd</sup> Ave.
  - Hwy. 2 and E. 88<sup>th</sup> Ave.
  - Hwy. 2 and E. 96<sup>th</sup> Ave.



## Scope of Work

- Acquire cloud based software for developing performance measures
  - Proactive monitoring
  - Detection alerts at odd times of the day
  - Pedestrian alerts at odd times of the day
  - Traffic signal timing optimization
- Five years of software license, tech support, and upgrades



#### **Cost and Schedule**

- Lowest responsible bid from Lighthouse Transportation Group, LLC
  - Total Cost \$412,773
  - City Portion is \$223,173
  - CDOT Portion is \$189,600



### **Next Steps**

- Negotiate Final Contract with Lighthouse Transportation Group, LLC
- Notice to Proceed anticipated to be issued April
- Completion in 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2023.
