

RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING COMMITMENT TO RAMP PROJECT SH 2

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (the “City”) has applied to the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) for cost sharing, pursuant to a CDOT Public-Public Partnership (the “Cost Sharing”), related to the widening and other improvements to State Highway 2 within the City (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, to be eligible for the Cost Sharing, the City must adopt a resolution reaffirming its commitment to provide the City’s share of funding for the Project in accordance with the “Evidence of Applicant’s Commitment” attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City remains committed to entering into a Public-Public Partnership with CDOT concerning RAMP Project SH 2 in Commerce City in accordance with the Evidence of Applicant’s Commitment and the project scope, schedule and budget attached thereto.
2. The City Manager and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Evidence of Applicant’s Commitment on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
