

ORDINANCE NO. 1978

INTRODUCED BY: AMADOR, BENSON, BULLOCK, DOUGLAS, ELLIOTT, FORD, MCELLOWNEY, TETER

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2009 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY THROUGH ORDINANCE 1907.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 3301.1.3 of the International Fire Code, previously adopted by the City of Commerce City through Ordinance 1907, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3301.1.3 Fireworks. The possession, manufacture, storage, sale, handling and use of fireworks is prohibited.

Exceptions:

1. Storage and handling of fireworks as allowed in Section 3304
2. Manufacture, assembly and testing of fireworks as allowed in Section 3305.
3. The use of fireworks for fireworks displays as allowed in Section 3308.

SECTION 2. Section 5-41001 of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code shall be revised to incorporate this new amendment to the International Fire Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2014.
