A penalty of nine days suspension, with four days to be served from 12:01 a.m. February 21, 2015, through 11:59 p.m. February 24, 2015. The remaining five days would be held in abeyance for a period of one year.

Attorney Tooley presented copies of TIPS training cards for the employees and photos of the warning signs posted throughout the licensed premises. These were tendered
