Hi Dalton,

I hope your week is going well. Below I have answered the questions you had for us in regards to the CU permit. Please let me know if you have any further questions. Also, when you get a chance, I would like to speak to you about the neighborhood meeting requirements so I can start working on that.

- 1. Are the conditions from the previous approval still being met?
  - 1. Are you still meeting the maximum of 136 clients? Yes, but capacity has been low due to Covid restrictions. Numbers are continually increasing back to full capacity. Facility capacity can be verified via the ACCCB and DCJ at any time.
  - 2. Is this still operating as a same-sex facility? All male or female? Same sex facility, all males
  - 3. How often does the ACCCB meet? ACCCB meets monthly, on the second Tuesday.
    - Only when new referrals are received? The screening committee meets bi
      weekly to review the designee's suitability for placement at the
      Facility. Referrals can be denied based on specific guidelines and contractual
      criteria and requirements. ACCCB hosts this meeting and documents all data
- 2. Can you provide more data on the clients?
  - 1. The most common types of crimes committed. All clients in the facility are serving felony sentences, with the majority of clients suffering from substance abuse disorder. We see a vast range of charges from controlled substance and assault to criminal mischief.
  - Success rate of transitioning clients out of the facility- Fiscal year 2021, the state average for success rate was 61%, Commerce Transitional Center was at 63%. All Community Correction program outcomes can be monitored on the DCJ website.
    - Any repeat offenders or clients that return to the facility after being transitioned out. There is a chance that a nonresidential client will be brought back in house for additional supervision, if they show signs of regression in their sobriety or criminal behavior. About 20% of all terminations are regressions back to the facility.
