

**RESOLUTION APPROVING RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENT FOR METRO
WASTEWATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Metro Wastewater Reclamation District (“District”) is planning its Second Creek Project to connect existing public sanitary sewer infrastructure from the area south of Denver International Airport to the District’s South Platte Interceptor pipeline near 136th Ave. and the South Platte River (“Project”);

WHEREAS, the Project generally plans to follow the Second Creek drainage and may be constructed within open space and other property owned by the City of Commerce City (“City”);

WHEREAS, the District has requested, and the City desires to grant, the District and its contractors the right to access certain City-owned property for the purposes of planning, design, and testing activities for the Project as set forth in the attached Permission to Enter Property and Right of Entry Agreement (“Agreement”);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Agreement is in the best interests of the City and the public.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the Agreement on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
