## REQUEST

Approve Ordinance 2747 if City Council would like to require door-to-door solicitors selling goods, services or any other thing of value to wear identification badges while soliciting.

## BACKGROUND

On September 15, 2025, City Council approved a motion directing the City Manager and staff to draft an ordinance requiring all door-to-door solicitors operating within Commerce City to always display a visible and clearly legible identification badge while soliciting.

Ordinance 2747 amends section 12-5005 of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code to modify the solicitations on posted property provisions to address Council's desire.

It will still be unlawful for any person to enter or remain upon any public or private property in the City for the purpose of soliciting when a "No Solicitation" or "No Trespassing" sign is posted at or near the entrances to such premises unless the permission of the owner, agent, representative or occupant of the premises has been previously obtained.
