

ORDINANCE NO. 2521

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE JAG/BYRNE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,001 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program is the leading source of federal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions. The JAG Program provides states, tribes, and local governments with critical funding necessary to support a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution, indigent defense, courts, crime prevention and education, corrections and community corrections, drug treatment and enforcement, planning, evaluation, technology improvement, crime victim and witness initiatives, mental health programs and related law enforcement and corrections programs, including behavioral programs and crisis intervention teams, and implementation of state crisis intervention court proceedings and related programs or initiatives including, but not limited to, mental health courts, drug courts, veterans courts, and extreme risk protection order programs; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to purchase rifle plates and helmets to be used by police department personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. An amendment is made to the 2023 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Department of Justice – Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant funds for \$29,001. The funds for the purchase of rifle plates and ballistic helmets to be used by public safety department personnel (Fund 180).

SECTION 2. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.
