AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE TONY GRAMPSAS YOUTH SERVICES (TGYS) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$79,739 FOR THE SUPPORT OF ACTIVITIES AND CLASSES TO COMMUNITY YOUTH AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City has been awarded a Tony Grampsas Youth Services grant in the amount of \$79,739 from the TGYS Board to fund the expense of prevention, intervention, and education programs for children, youth, and their families designed to prevent youth crime and violence, youth marijuana use, and child abuse and neglect.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2.** An amendment is made to the 2022 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the TGYS Board in the amount of \$79,739 to be used for the provision of youth services within the city. (Fund 180)

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
