

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR REPLACEMENT
OF EAST 112TH AVENUE BRIDGE OVER FULTON DITCH TO JALISCO
INTERNATIONAL INC.**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) desires to have the 112th Avenue Bridge over the Fulton Ditch reconstructed, as set forth in Project 2020-01-PW (“Project”);

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in a formal, competitive bidding process consistent with applicable requirements to select a contractor to complete the Project, and, after reviewing all of the bids, City staff has determined that the lowest responsive and responsible bidder whose bid provides the best value to the City is Jalisco International, Inc. (“Contractor”); and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City of the Project will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City’s procurement policies and the City Manager’s commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. The City Council finds that the award of the Project to the Contractor is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Acceptance of Bid; Contract Authorization. The Contractor’s bid in the amount of \$1,230,027.35 is hereby accepted, and the award of the contract for the completion of the Project in that amount to the Contractor is hereby approved, subject to the successful negotiation and execution of a written contract. This resolution shall not be deemed to grant any right to or interest in the award of the contract to the Contractor until the execution of a written contract acceptable to the City Manager. Upon successful finalization of the contract and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the contract on behalf of the City.
