

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR
HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL ROUNDUP PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Tri-County Health Department (“Tri-County”) annually sponsors a program known as the Adams County Household Chemical Roundup Program (the “HCR Program”) for the citizens of Adams County to provide a safe and viable disposal option for household hazardous waste;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (the “City”), as well as other governmental entities within Adams County, including the County of Adams, the City of Federal Heights, the City of Brighton and the City of Thornton, has consistently provided funding for the HCR Program;

WHEREAS, while the participating governmental entities act collectively as a committee within the HCR Program, each must enter into a separate intergovernmental agreement with Tri-County;

WHEREAS, the HCR Program serves a vital function in helping to prevent household chemicals from entering storm sewers and landfills and unintentionally contaminating land and water; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that participation in the HCR Program is and will be in the best interest of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The attached Intergovernmental Agreement for Household Chemical Roundup Program (the “HCR IGA”) is hereby approved.
2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the HCR IGA on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
