A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF INTERIM CITY ATTORNEY EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of Commerce City, Colorado, by previous Resolution No. 2021-100, appointed of Matthew R. Hader ("Mr. Hader") as the Interim City Attorney for a limited period of time;

WHEREAS, subsequent to the interim appointment, the City has posted the position of City Attorney and conducted a recruitment unsuccessfully;

WHEREAS, while the City continues with its recruitment efforts, the City Council desires to extend the appointment of Mr. Hader pending the recruitment and appointment of a permanent City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Appointment. Mr. Hader's appointment as the Interim City Attorney for the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is extended as set forth in and subject to the terms and conditions of Amendment to the Interim Employment Agreement, attached as Exhibit A, and the original Agreement.

SECTION 3. Approval of Agreement. The Amendment to the Interim Employment Agreement attached as Exhibit A is hereby approved. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and attest to the Amendment to the Interim Employment Agreement, substantially in the form attached, on behalf of the city of Commerce City.
