

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ATKINS NORTH
AMERICA, INC. FOR COLORADO BLVD. AND 72ND AVENUE RAIL LINE STATION
AREA IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) desires to engage in a public improvement project to make roadway and pedestrian access improvements between 70th Avenue and 72nd Avenue prior to the opening of the new RTD rail line station (“Project”);

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in a formal competitive procurement for an engineering consultant to provide preliminary and final engineering design, survey, environmental and right of way services for the Project;

WHEREAS, the City has selected Atkins North America, Inc. (“Atkins”) to perform these services and has reached an agreement, attached as Exhibit A (“Agreement”), as to the terms and conditions under which Atkins will provide the services for the Project;

WHEREAS, the cost to the City of the Services will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City’s procurement policies and the City Manager’s commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The award to Atkins and the Agreement, substantially in the form attached, are hereby approved;
2. Upon successful finalization of the Agreement and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the Agreement on behalf of the City for an amount not to exceed a \$292,000.
