# Amendment to the 2022 Annual Action Plan (AAP)

We are currently in the fiscal year (FY) and program year 2022, which runs from October 1<sup>st</sup> 2022-September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023

- CDBG funds for FY 2022 were \$422,541
- Funds increased for FY 2022 due to FY 2021 reallocated metropolitan area entitlement funds under Section 106(c) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974,
  - Increased HUD allocation = \$17,834
- Amendment of Reallocation of uncommitted prior year funds (PY 2019 and 2020)
  - \$56,279 to be reallocated to Housing Programs and Public Facilities
