#### Title

Resolution setting the public hearing date for annexation AN-259-21-22.

### **Summary and Background Information**

The applicant is requesting approval for the annexation of approximately 36 acres, located on a parcel of land generally located at the southwest corner of E. 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Highway 85. The property to be annexed is owned by the QuikTrip Corporation and will be developed as a gas station/convenience store, along with additional commercial and high-density residential uses in conformance with the City's Comprehensive Plan and the proposed PUD. A vicinity map has been included for the specific location. All the property is currently zoned with an Adams County Industrial-1 (I-1) zoning designation and is requested to be rezoned to Commerce City Planned Unit Development (PUD) via annexation zoning case Z-964-21-22, which is being processed concurrently. The public hearing for this annexation case is scheduled for May 16, 2022. The petition has been reviewed and accepted by the City staff.
