WHEREAS, Monaco Park ("Park"), located in the City of Commerce City ("City"), recently completed a renovation project;

WHEREAS, the City desires to add another amenity to the renovation project;

WHEREAS, the amenity the City desires to add is a Story Walk, an innovative initiative designed to promote literacy and physical activity by deconstructing a children's book and mounting each page along a walking path in the Park (the "Project");

WHEREAS, the City applied to Adams County ("County") for grant funding from the Adams County Open Space Grant ("ACOS");

WHEREAS, the County accepted the City's application and approved a grant to fund the Project (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the City and County wish to enter into an agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, regarding the Grant ("Agreement").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.
