Per board member request, below is a three-year summary of funding received by the Adams 14 School District, showing all funding sources tracked by CDE. Funding sources include local and state share (property tax) provided via the school finance formula; local bond and mill levy override revenues; COVID relief funds, notably Coronavirus Relief Funds (CRF) and three Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds; competitive grants; and formula grants.

The summary indicates that the district is anticipating \$79.2M, as compared to \$100.7M last year and \$88.0M the year prior. The biggest source of difference between the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 anticipated funding is the awarding of \$6.7M of ESSER II and \$15.2M of ESSER III funding in 2020-2021, increasing the annual funding for the district significantly in that year.
