

Tower Road Widening Project-Award of Construction Contract



Project Goals

The project is intended to accomplish the following:

- Increased vehicle capacity
- Improved safety
- Improved level of service
- Environmentally & contextually sensitive
- Multi-modal facilities for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians
- Water quality and storm water conveyance improvements

Contract Bid Process

- Bids were solicited through a formal bidding process which was advertised on the City website and Rocky Mountain E-Purchasing beginning on February 29, 2016
- Bids were opened and read publicly at 2:00 p.m. on April 7, 2016
- Both asphalt and concrete pavement were bid as alternates since a life cycle cost analysis showed that the cost of each was within 10% of each other
