

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MINIMUM BUDGETARY FUNDING FOR THE
BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City, on June 20, 2022, expressed interest in giving specified boards and commissions an operating budget and passed a motion to “increase all board and commission budgets by \$10,000”;

WHEREAS, following the June 20, 2022 direction and vote, staff identified a disproportionate allocation of funds across the designated boards and commissions and brought that to the attention of the full City Council at the September 12, 2022, budget retreat;

WHEREAS, in response, City Council determined that all specified boards and commissions would be allocated an equal amount of \$12,500, and all newly created boards or commissions would be allocated an initial amount of \$5,000 unless exempted and until an otherwise appropriate budget can be determined;

WHEREAS, this Resolution establishes a \$12,500 budget for the Citizens Public Safety Advisory Board, Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Commission, Parks, Recreation, & Golf Advisory Committee, Senior Commission, Veterans Commission, and Youth Commission without the need to alter the \$60,000 allocated to boards and commissions in the 2023 budget; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that all boards and commissions are able to adequately perform their duties as assigned, City Council resolves to provide a budget for all established, non-quasi-judicial, or non-profit boards and commissions as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Current Boards and Commissions. A budget of \$12,500 is allocated to each of the following boards and commissions for the 2023 budget: Citizens Public Safety Advisory Board, Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Commission, Parks, Recreation, & Golf Advisory Committee, Senior Commission, Veterans Commission, and Youth Commission.

SECTION 3. Future Boards and Commissions. All boards and commissions established after the effective date of this resolution shall be allocated \$5,000 as an initial budget until such time as a budgetary amendment is warranted and subsequently approved.
