

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
CONCERNING THE ADAMS COUNTY COMMUNITY TRANSIT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) and Adams County, along with other municipalities, formed the Adams County Community Transit Policy Council and Community Transit Program (also known as ALIFT) to facilitate the development of special transit services within the County; and

WHEREAS, the City and Adams County desire to update the intergovernmental agreement regarding the Adams County Community Transit Policy Council and Community Transit Program, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit A (“Intergovernmental Agreement”) to facilitate the continuation of ALIFT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY:

1. The City Council finds and declares that the Intergovernmental Agreement, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit A, is in the best interests of the City and its residents and is hereby approved.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City.
