

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY AND ADAMS 14 SCHOOL DISTRICT
REGARDING REPLACEMENT/RECONSTRUCTION OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
BASEBALL/SOFTBALL FIELDS**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (the “City”) uses various baseball/softball fields at Adams County School District 14 (“ACSD 14”) elementary schools in order to provide youth and sports programming through the City’s Department of Parks, Recreation & Golf;

WHEREAS, over 350 children participate annually in the City’s youth baseball program, and over 120 children participate annually in the City-facilitated CCYA girls softball program;

WHEREAS, continued use by the City of the ACSD 14 baseball/softball fields (the “Ballfields”) is therefore critical to the success of the City’s youth sports programs;

WHEREAS, the Ballfields have not been renovated since construction in the early 1960s, and conditions at the Ballfields have deteriorated significantly over time;

WHEREAS, City staff have negotiated the attached Intergovernmental Agreement with ACSD 14 (the “Ballfields Restoration IGA”), which would allow the City to repair the Ballfields beginning with the two that have been identified as needing the most immediate attention; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Ballfields Restoration IGA and hereby finds and determines that entering into the Ballfields Restoration IGA is and shall be in the best interests of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The attached Ballfields Restoration IGA is hereby approved.
2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Ballfields Restoration IGA on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
