This map displays the Rocky Mountain Arsenal National Wildlife Refuge, highlighted in green. The refuge is situated in the northeast quadrant of the map, bordered by major transportation corridors. To the west, Interstate 25 (I-25) runs north-south, while Interstate 76 (I-76) runs east-west. To the south, Interstate 70 (I-70) is visible. The Denver International Airport is located to the east of the refuge. The map includes a grid of streets, with major thoroughfares such as E-128th Ave, E-120th Ave, E-112th Ave, E-96th Ave, E-88th Ave, E-80th Ave, E-74th Ave, E-64th Ave, E-60th Ave, E-56th Ave, Thornton Pkwy, Brighton Blvd, and Quebec St. The area is also characterized by several creeks, including Tonguewood Creek, First Creek, and Adams Creek.
