AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$79,449 FOR SUPPORT LICENSED FACILITIES THAT SERVE CHILDREN THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$79,449 from the Colorado Department of Human Services to fund to be used for the support of licensed facilities that serve children thereof is hereby authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. An amendment is made to the 2022 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Colorado Department of Human Services Child Case Operations Stabilizations and Workforce Sustainability Grant in the amount of \$79,449 to be used for support licensed facilities that serve children.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
