REQUEST

Approve a resolution awarding a construction contract to Martin Marietta Materials, Inc. in the amount of \$3,064,108.66 for the annual pavement management program for asphalt streets throughout the city.

BACKGROUND

The City has an annual program for pavement management. A major component of this program is the mill and overlay which is a rehabilitative method to extend the service life of the roadway. In the process, 1.5" - 2" of the existing pavement is milled and replaced by new asphalt. The work being performed under this contract includes mill and overlay at locations provided by the Public Works Department (see Project Map). The streets with a solid red line on the maps are included in the mill and overlay contract. The City advertised this project for request for bids from March 17, 2025 to April 8, 2025. The City received six bids from the contractors. The lowest responsible bidder was Martin Marietta Materials, Inc., with a bid of three million sixty-four thousand one hundred eight dollars and sixty six cents (\$3,064,108.66).
