#### 57th Annual Commerce City Memorial Day Parade coming May 29

Colorado's largest Memorial Day Parade will bring thousands of people to the heart of Commerce City on Monday, May 29 at 9:30 a.m. The city's Memorial Day Ceremony starts off the day's events at 8:45 a.m. at Veterans Memorial park, 6015 Forest Dr. The city is thrilled to welcome floats, vehicles, military organizations, horse groups, and more from around the region to show their patriotic colors as we honor those who have sacrificed for our country.

After the parade, high-energy cover band "HomeSlice" will entertain the crowd with a concert at Veterans Memorial Park. The event will also feature six food trucks and booths from veterans' service organizations, city boards and commissions, and area nonprofit groups. #### **Hot Shot Crew**

## **Executive Summary**

This update is intended to provide a weekly update of environmental policy and planning work including, but not limited to:

- Environmental Policy Advisory Committee (EPAC), Lotus Contract and Community Outreach
- Municipal Sustainability
- Updates on information regarding the Suncor Refinery and its operations
- Legislative Updates & Regional Environmental Leadership (Party Status Consent Agenda)
- Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Regulations & Applications

#### **Environmental Policy Advisory Committee (EPAC) and Community Outreach**

Interviews were completed for the 2023 EPAC cohort. Several veteran members are returning which will assist in continuity. New members include Cultivando personnel and a member of the Youth Council which provide bridges to the academic and nonprofit for stronger grant, educational and project collaboration. Staff provided on-boarding to new members that covered the Sustainability Action Plan development, measurable targets, and top sector (i.e., education, energy efficiency, renewables, waste diversion, active transportation, community health, adaptation and mitigation, biodiversity, tree canopy, water conservation and food security) recommendations. EPAC members are coordinating with the Northglenn citizens advisory committee to discuss best practices and regional collaboration.

Dr Russo is working with Recreation staff to help promote monthly sustainability challenges. May's challenges include activities related to water conservation and energy efficiency.



#### **Lotus Engineering & Sustainability Contract Progress**

The Municipal GHG Inventory deliverable will be submitted this month. The inventory task was complicated because select data had not been tracked that feed into the calculations such as commuting habits, weights of trash, food waste and recyclables. To complete the task, all extrapolated data assumptions will be documented for quality control. A contract schedule extension will be included on June 12 Council meeting.

#### **Municipal Sustainability**

CMO, PW and CD staff are coordinating on a proposal to add EV infrastructure charging and researching funding opportunities for fleet vehicles. As part of the EV initiatives, training material and community outreach campaign will be included.

CD and HR staff are partnering to include sustainability training opportunities including a lending library of books and movies to increase internal sustainability capacity. Both EPAC and Sustainability Team members ranked education and capacity building as critical to creating a sustainability culture within the organization and community.

## **Suncor Refinery**

Staff contacted Suncor to set up a meeting about GEMM and meet the new Vice President. Suncor had a water permit upset during the recent flooding. Staff met with several CDPHE Records staff to learn about the various databases to track different types of records including exceedances, upsets, violations, and compliance orders as well as the GIS tracking maps.

Staff met with Detlev, the atmospheric scientist conducting the air sampling for Cultivando to discuss partnership opportunities.

#### Legislative Updates & Regional and State Environmental Protection Leadership

As discussed in the Council Study Session, staff recommends that three items be added to the consent agenda at an upcoming council meeting: Methane Intensity Rulemaking; GEMMs 2 Rulemaking and the extension of the Lotus contract.

Regarding the Methane Intensity Rulemaking, 42 city and county governments will be seeking party status. The new regulation seeks to verify emission data that currently is self-reported by facilities. The coalition of local governments have expressed disappointment in APCD's rule proposals for their failure to include standards

guaranteeing the accurate and reliable quantification of real-world methane emissions. Staff have submitted comments but recommend that Commerce City formally become a party to the rulemaking.

GEMMs 2 is the second rule-making that has the potential to significantly reduce carbon pollution in Commerce City because the regulation will pertain to Suncor operations. Several recent edits to the GEMMs rulemaking could negatively affect Commerce City including but not limited to:

- Inappropriately broad trading for facilities with a history of non-compliance (i.e., Suncor).
- Failure to protect or prioritize pollution reductions in disproportionally impacted communities (DIC).
- Complicated compliance options erode protections and undermine statutory intent.
  - o Cost-effectiveness threshold vastly undervalues human health especially cumulative impacts.
  - o No exclusion from trading for facilities near DICs or serial air quality violators
  - The option to use a "state-managed fund" and CCUS/DAC
- The rule is complicated and inaccessible to allow meaningful engagement by DICs; and
- Undefined amounts for penalties.

Staff submitted a letter of Intent for state funding on behalf of the Front Range Local Government Air Monitoring Coalition, a group of five local governments committed to researching and improving air quality in the Front Range. The coalition is comprised of City & County of Broomfield, Boulder County, Town of Erie, and City of Longmont, four local governments that have sponsored research-grade continuous air quality monitoring of a comprehensive suite of air pollutants and Commerce City, which hosts 9 stationary and 1 mobile community air monitoring sites, and tracks fence line monitors at Suncor and Phillips 66.

The proposal will be focused on modeling work that will utilize ozone data from CDPHE monitoring sites alongside data collected continuously by Boulder Atmosphere Innovations (Boulder A.I.R.) in the jurisdictions of the Front Range Local Government Air Monitoring Coalition. The results of our research project will refine the current understanding of ozone source areas that directly affect Commerce City.

#### Oil & Gas Updates

Staff hasn't received a response from COGCC regarding the schedule for the plugging and abandonment of wells and any scheduled inspections particularly related to PDC operations. Additionally, staff has requested historical records on P&A wells within our growth area and city limits relative to PDC fracking and the Settler's Crossing development application.

No new Oil & Gas spacing, or permit applications have been submitted to the city.
